

# GET OUT THE VOTE

## in Alaska

Voting is one of the most powerful ways to make your voice heard in our democracy, but in 2024, only 64% of the voting-age population in the United States reported voting.

Modern technology has improved access to information on candidates and made it easier to register to vote in many areas, and it is vital to be aware of how you can participate in the 2026 election cycle.

### PRIMARY ELECTION TYPE:

## Top-Four

Candidates are listed on a common ballot regardless of party. In this system, the top four vote-getters advance to the general election.



### ABSENTEE AND MAIL-IN VOTING PROCEDURES

#### Permanent absentee/ mail-in voting procedures:

- No excuse required to request an absentee ballot
- Applications can be submitted by mail, in-person, email, fax, or online

### DEADLINES TO KNOW FOR VOTING IN

## Alaska



### VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE:

**July 20**

30 days before the election.

### ABSENTEE / MAIL-IN VOTING BALLOT DEADLINES:

Request must be received by

**August 8**

10 days before the election for mail requests; 5 PM the day before the election for online applications.

### BALLOT SUBMISSION DEADLINE:

**Postmarked by Election Day**

Must be received within 10 days if postmarked on or before Election Day.
