

GET OUT THE VOTE

in Nevada

Voting is one of the most powerful ways to make your voice heard in our democracy, but in 2024, only 64% of the voting-age population in the United States reported voting.

Modern technology has improved access to information on candidates and made it easier to register to vote in many areas, and it is vital to be aware of how you can participate in the 2026 election cycle.

PRIMARY ELECTION TYPE:

Partially Open

This system allows voters to cross party lines, but their ballot selection may be regarded as a form of registration with the corresponding party.



ABSENTEE AND MAIL-IN VOTING PROCEDURES

Permanent absentee/ mail-in voting procedures:

Ballots are delivered to all voters.

DEADLINES TO KNOW FOR VOTING IN

Nevada



VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE:

May 12

28 days before the election in-person; postmarked 28 days before if registering by mail; online registration may take place until election day Same-day registration is permitted during early voting and on Election Day.

ABSENTEE / MAIL-IN VOTING BALLOT DEADLINES:

Ballots are delivered to all voters

BALLOT SUBMISSION DEADLINE:

Postmarked by Election Day

Must be received by 5 PM on the fourth day following the election if postmarked by Election Day.
